1.	<p>In relation to your answers numbered 2 and 3 from 15 February 2019 regarding the documents, already signed by the bidders prior to the extension of the Submission Deadline until 3 April 2019, please confirm whether there is a specific form of the required declaration for lack of changes to the declared circumstances. Our understanding is that such a declaration would suffice to be in simple written form, with ordinary (simple) signature, in Bulgarian language (respectively, with an unofficial translation in Bulgarian language), signed by the respective persons, who have already signed the respective forms/documents, which are to be presented alongside the Application and/or the Offer. Please also confirm whether the declaration may address several/ all documents, signed by the same person. Please confirm where is such a declaration to be provided, in our opinion - with the Application, recorded in electronic form on the respective CD or other recording device, respectively verified with the electronic signature of the Lead Member.</p>	<p>Revised Tender Documents will be published soon and will contain the proposed declaration and relevant instructions.</p>
2.	<p>Please confirm whether you expect other changes in the Tender Documents other than the last ones, regarding only the extension of the Submission Deadline of Applications and Offers until 3 April 2019 (in relation to your answer numbered 5 from 15 February 2019) and if yes, when. In this regard, please upload the latest Tender Documents in Word form in Bulgarian and in English language.</p>	<p>No material changes are envisaged in relation to the Tender Documents. Revised Tender Documents and draft Concessions Agreement will be published soon.</p>
3.	<p>Some sample forms require a stamp of the applicant (declarator, bidder). Since under the applicable Bulgarian legislation the stamp is not a mandatory element, our understanding is that the Grantor shall not require a stamp, including in case of bidders - foreign entities. Please confirm our understanding.</p>	<p>The stamp is not mandatory and would apply only if the constitutional documents of the Bidder/entity issuing the relevant declaration/form require the confirmation of a signature through the Bidder's / entity's stamp.</p>
