Please provide proof of the fulfilment of Sofia Airport EAD's obligations, pursuant to the Waste Management Act, as well as the applicable legal regulations, as follows:	
<p>1. Please, submit an example worksheet on the Waste Classification per waste type, produced by Sofia Airport EAD, approved by the director of the Regional Environment and Waters Inspectorate, pursuant to Ordinance No. 2 of 23.07.2014.</p>	<p>In compliance with the Waste Management Act (WMA) and the relevant applicable legal regulations Sofia Airport EAD submits its production and hazardous waste to specialized companies, licensed as waste-treatment operators, according to art. 35 of the WMA.</p> <p>For every waste, generated by the Company, it has obtained a Waste Classification Worksheet, endorsed by the Regional Environment and Waters Inspectorate /REWI/ – Sofia. Schedule 5.6.9. of the Electronic Section – file I.1.1 contains a List of worksheets by waste codes and names according to the Ordinance on Waste Classification.</p> <p>This information is available for review in the Electronic Data Room - schedule 5.6.9. files I.1.2. – I.1.22 (waste classification worksheets, endorsed by REWI-Sofia.)</p>
<p>2. Please, provide the annual reports for 2017, as well as the monthly reports for the period 01.2018 – 01.07.2018, required in accordance with Ordinance No. 1 of 4.06.2014 on the rules and templates, to be used for the submission of information, regarding the waste-management activities, as well as regarding the rules on keeping public registers.</p>	<p>According to the Waste Management Act, Sofia Airport EAD prepares and submits to the Executive Environment Agency (EEA)/the Ministry of Environment and Waters (MEW) annual reports on the production or hazardous waste generated, according to Ordinance No. 1 on the rules and templates, to be used for the submission of information, regarding the waste-management activities, as well as regarding the rules on keeping public registers of 04.06.2014 of the MEW.</p> <p>This information is available for review in the Electronic Data Room - schedule 5.6.9. file I.2. (the annual reports for 2017 on the production or hazardous waste generated 2017 and the notification for production or hazardous waste, which have not been generated and/or with which no specific activities have been performed by the Sofia Airport EAD for 2017)</p>

	<p>The monthly reporting, according to Ordinance No.1 of 04.06.2014 is carried out through the reporting registers on generated production and/or hazardous waste, bilaterally endorsed by Sofia Airport EAD and REWI - Sofia. The reporting registers are kept for every site by waste codes and completed on a monthly basis, with information, regarding the waste management activities performed/not performed.</p>
<p><u>Activities, according to the LAREAROOP</u></p>	
<p>According to Article 2.3. of the Concession Contract with respect to item 1.7, (v) of Appendix 5 to the Concession Contract, the Concessionaire should acquire, as a condition precedent to the performance, a ground handling operator license, for, but not limited to, the activity „provision of aircraft services, including fuels and oils“.</p>	
<p>In addition to this license, should the Concessionaire registered also under the Law on the Administrative Regulation of Economic Activities, Related to Oil and Oil Products, promulgated in State Gazette, issue No. 62 of 27.07.2018 effective, as of 28.01.2019 (“LAREAROOP“), for the following activities:</p>	
<p>1. <i>For the activity “Wholesale of Oil and Oil Products“</i> (even if the Concessionaire carries out direct sales of oil and oil products to air carriers - end-users);</p>	
<p>2. <i>For the activity „Storage of oil and oil products“</i>. If the answer is yes, please, clarify how the relations will be governed, considering the requirements, set out in the LAREAROOP, as special registration conditions, the person, who shall register, should have its own or rented storage vessels, and carry out storage only within facilities, located in premises and/or areas, owned or rented by such person for performing the relevant activities, considering the fact that the Concession Contract does not transfer to the Concessionaire the ownership of the fuel storage warehouses, nor of the oil storage premises or areas storage, and it does not establish any rental relations between the State and the Concessionaire, regarding such fuel storage vessels, premises and/or areas; as well as</p>	<p>The Bidder, who is awarded the Concession shall observe all necessary requirements, as specified in the applicable legislation, in order to meet the conditions precedent. Our preliminary position is that such a registration will be required. In addition, and as far as the administrative regulation of the activities, pursuant to that act (LAREAROOP), is performed by the Minister of Economy, we shall request an official position from the Minister and announce the result as soon as practicable.</p>
